REPORT OF THE MEETING OF THE MINISTERS IN CHARGE OF HEALTHCARE OF THE BSEC MEMBER STATES

Athens, 29 September 2014

- 1. The Meeting of the Ministers in charge of Healthcare of the BSEC Member States was held in Athens, Hellenic Republic, on 29 September 2014.
- 2. The Meeting was chaired by H.E. Mr. Mavroudis VORIDIS, Minister of Health of the Hellenic Republic

NETWORK FOR THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE WITHIN THE BSEC REGION

(HEALTHCARE AND PHARMACEUTICS)

- The Network for the Emergency Preparedness and Response (NET-EPR) in the field of healthcare within the BSEC Region is formed as a mechanism of regular and systematic exchange of information (all-hazards approach covering all categories of threat regardless of their origin) among the participating BSEC Member States.
- 2. Acknowledging the importance of regional cooperation for preparedness and response to health threats, the NET-EPR will function in accordance with the new International Health Regulation (IHR) of the World Health Organization (WHO).
- 3. The aim of the NET-EPR is to exchange information in real time among the participating partners, regarding
 - a) the communicable diseases/epidemiological issues (risk analysis/assessment, real-time exchange of information);
 - b) pharmaceutical related events as well as, to the extent possible, in the public health interrelated cases of
 - natural hazards (earthquakes, extreme weather conditions, landslides, forest fires, floods, volcanic eruptions, health risks connected with migrant flow etc.;
 - technological accidents (chemical accidents at industrial facilities):
 - accidents in transporting hazardous materials and goods;
 - transport accidents (road, railway, sea, air);
 - massive casualties:
 - events that fall in CBRN-e categories.
- 4. The participating BSEC Member States shall nominate their National Focal Points to the NET-EPR.
- 5. The NET-EPR will implement an online application which will also include a forum (internet access) restricted to the registered BSEC Member States with all security conditions according to the international safety regulations.

- 6. The function of the NET-EPR will not affect the right of the participating BSEC Member States to implement any measures or procedures for protecting the health of the population in their territories.
- 7. The participation to the NET-EPR will not affect the obligation of the BSEC Member States to report health events in accordance with WHO and EU rules and regulations or in accordance with other bilateral or multilateral agreements already in force (within the BSEC region or otherwise).
- 8. The NET-EPR will be administrated, on a rotation basis, by a competent National Authority of the participating BSEC Member States (on a voluntary basis), according to the period of coordination in the relevant Working Group.
- 9. The NET-EPR coordinator will report, on a regular basis, to the BSEC Working Group on Healthcare and Pharmaceutics.
- 10. The coordination of the NET-EPR establishment and operation for the initial two years period will be provided by the National Health Operations Center of the Hellenic Ministry of Health.

DECLARATION

of

the Ministers in Charge of Healthcare of the BSEC Member States (Athens, 29 September 2014)

We, the Ministers in charge of Healthcare and Pharmaceutics of the BSEC Member States,

Recognizing the need of strengthening cooperation in the sphere of public health and pharmaceutics in the BSEC region;

Desirous to intensify interaction on health issues through programmes and concrete projects of common interest;

Acknowledging the importance of regional cooperation in improving the preparedness and response of our countries to health threats;

Guided by the "BSEC Economic Agenda Towards an Enhanced BSEC Partnership", endorsed at the Summit on the 20th Anniversary of the BSEC on 26 June 2012;

Taking stock of the Decision of the Thirtieth Meeting of the Council of the Ministers of Foreign Affairs of the BSEC Member States in Varna on 19 June 2014, which instructed the relevant BSEC Working Group to proceed with the designed schedule for creating a Network on emergency preparedness and response to health threats with all hazards approach and establishing a system of regular exchange of information among the BSEC Member States;

Affirming the need to implement the International Health Regulations (2005) under the World Health Organization (WHO) guidance for the coordination in management of events that may constitute a public health emergency of international concern;

Based on the priorities of cooperation in the field of healthcare and pharmaceutics of the Hellenic BSEC Chairmanship-in-Office "Building Support for Economic Cooperation-BSEC";

We declare our resolution to:

- 1. *Encourage* the relevant National Administrations of the BSEC Member States to coordinate their actions, in order to allow the regular and systematic exchange of information on health threats:
- 2. *Develop* regional approaches, as appropriate, for networking between the competent Authorities in the BSEC region;
- 3. Establish a "Network for the Emergency Preparedness and Response within the BSEC Region (NET-EPR) in the field of healthcare", to function in accordance with the International Health Regulation (IHR) of the World Health Organization (WHO), with the aim to ensure the exchange of information on health threats, in real time, between the participating BSEC Member States.

We express our gratitude to the Government of the Hellenic Republic for the organization of the Meeting and for the hospitality extended.
