Promoting Equity in Access to Health Services with Financial Protection

Please **Save the date** and join a side event on migration health with a focus on access, financial protection and UHC. The event aims to address the health needs of migrants in the current context based on examples of concrete instruments that were recently adopted in global fora, in particular the WHO global action plan on the health of migrants and refugees, as well as the Global Compact on Migration.

Other overarching objectives include international cooperation, sharing of best practices, regional and country perspectives and implementation, such as overall challenges.

UHC will not be truly universal nor SDG 3.8 and SDG 10.7 achieved, unless health service coverage and financial protection measures in all countries include migrants, especially those in vulnerable situations.
