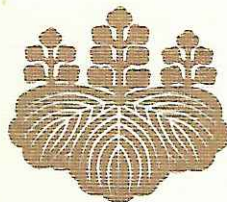

The Embassy of Japan in Georgia presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Georgia and has the honour to inform that the Government of Japan, having been playing its role as one of the leading states to promote "Universal Health Coverage (UHC)", proposes to hold the Web meeting within the Group of the Friends of UHC in a form of closed online conference, for about one hour between 15:30 and 17:00 (Georgian time) on one of the following days: September 28, October 1, or October 2. (NY time between 07:30 and 09:00 of the aforementioned days).

2 Remarks by main participants

- Remarks by Secretary General or Deputy Secretary General of UN.
- Remarks by Co-chairman States, Georgia and Thailand.
- Remarks by 4 countries (France, United Kingdom, India, and one of the countries in Africa).
- Remarks by 2 International organizations among WHO, UNICEF, Gavi/the Vaccine Alliance etc.).

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(Each remarks are supposed to last about 3 minutes)

4 Closing

The Government of Japan, considering that Georgia is co-chairing this Group of Friends of UHC along with Japan and Thailand, sincerely hopes that the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Georgia, H.E.
