Diagnosis: - Epiphysiodesis 40% proximal tibia right post infectious
- Portal cavernoma (detected in February 2020)

Treatment received: - desepiphysiodesis operation in the right knee area,
- Hepatology aftercare, investigation to evaluate hepatic damage in the context of portal hypertension, regular aftercare of development (possible delay, if severe liver damage, risk of encephalopathy)

Prescribed medication: - Alagus and derotation osteotomy and other surgical intervention according to evolution, regular orthopaedic, aftercare, close monitoring of the growth. In his medical report, the Swiss doctor believes that the technical platform necessary for future surgical treatment is not available in Georgia.
- Potential hepatic surgery, potential interventional radiology, potential liver transplantation, Hepatology aftercare, investigation to evaluate hepatic damage in the context of portal hypertension, regular aftercare of development (possible delay, if severe liver damage, risk of encephalopathy). according to the latest medical report, without these treatments, the child could have irreversible and disabling health problems, or even cause death if severe hepato-cellular insufficiency sets in.
