ARRIVAL IN TALLINN

Lennart Meri Tallinn Airport is located 5.0 km southeast of the centre of Tallinn making the airport easily accessible.

On Tuesday, 12 June 2018 transportation is organised from the airport to the main meeting hotels (Radisson Blu Sky Hotel, Radisson Blu Hotel Olumpia, Nordic Hotel Forum). If traveling outside the arranged transportation schedules, please have a look on the alternative local transportation options below. In case of doubt please do not hesitate to contact us.

By tram

Public tram route no. 4 stop is located next to the terminal towards the city. Trams go from downtown to airport (and vice versa), for a timetable please see [here](#). The journey to the centre takes less than 10 minutes. Tram tickets cost 2 Euros when buying from the driver (please have small notes at hand). The closest stop to Radisson Blu Sky and Nordic Hotel Forum is Hobujaama stop. The closest to Radisson Blu Hotel Olümpia is Paberi stop. By bus

Bus no. 2 leaves from the airport to the city centre and port every 20-30 minutes, and operates from 6:30 AM until 11:30 PM. Single journey tickets can be bought from the driver and cost 2 Euros. The airport bus stop is on the level 0 down the escalator. The downtown bus stop is located on Laikmaa Street (A.Laikmaa stop) in front of the Tallink City Hotel. By taxi

A taxi stand is also just outside the departure hall. The fare from the airport to the city centre is about 7 Euros. The official taxi partners of Tallinn Airport are Tulika Takso, Tallink Takso, Airport Taxi and Tulika Premium, whose cars will be waiting for passengers in front of the arrival terminal. June is one of the sunniest months of the year in Tallinn and is characterised by the longest days of the entire year with more than 18 hours of daylight. At this time of the year the weather is generally mild and sunny with average daytime temperature of 15°C, while at night, it drops to an average low of 9°C.
