4. Connections from the airport to hotels

There are four main Barcelona airport transport options to the city centre. All of them are reliable, efficient and they all take more or less the same length of time.

Barcelona Airport Taxis

Travelling by taxi is a convenient way to get from the airport to the city, especially if you have a family or a lot of luggage. You will find the airport Barcelona taxi rank when you leave the airport main exit. The taxis operate all night and there are several hundred of them, so you do not have to worry about not being able to catch a cab.

The journey to the city centre will take you about 30-45 minutes depending on road traffic conditions.

Expect to pay around 30-40 Euro for the journey into the centre. All official Barcelona taxis are black and yellow and are required to charge you only the value on the meter (plus additional surcharges: supplement for each bag you are carrying and a supplement for travelling to/from the airport). You will find the rates displayed inside the cab.

Train (Renfe)

The train station is situated in terminal 2 of the Barcelona airport (5 minutes walk from the main entrances). As most flights arrive at terminal 1, a shuttle service is in place which takes you from terminal 1 to terminal 2.

The RENFE train service runs approximately every 30 minutes to and from Barcelona airport terminal 2, to the city centre. Travel time is approximately 25 minutes.

Price of a single ticket from the airport is **4.50** €. One of the best ticket options once you get to the city is to buy a "T-10" (**9.95** €) which can be used for the train (Renfe + ferrocarril), metro, regular bus (excluding Aerobus) and Tram. It allows 10 travels, each valid for 1 hour and 15 minutes. The T-10 ticket can be used on more than one means of transport and all are counted as a single journey, provided that your journey is less than 1 hour and 15 minutes. This means for

example, you can make changes at metro stops (provided you don't leave the metro), then leave the metro and jump on a bus to finish your journey or vice versa as long as the total length of the journey is less than 1 hour and 15 minutes. NOTE you cannot re-enter the metro once you have left it - this would count as another journey.

When travelling from the airport to the city centre you get off at **Barcelona Sants**. The best option is to buy a single ticket from the airport to **Barcelona Sants** and then to buy a T-10 ticket once you arrive there, which you will be able to use to get around the city.

From **Barcelona Sants** you will have to change for the Barcelona metro **O**underground system.

If you are staying at the <u>Amrey Sant Pau hotel or Htop BCN City</u>, you take the blue line (L5) with direction "Vall d'Hebron" and get off at "**Sant Pau Dos de Maig**" (3 stops). From there you will have to walk 10 minutes to reach the hotel.

If you are staying at the <u>Happy People Apartments Calle Córcega 703</u>, <u>Barcelona</u>, you take the blue line (L5) with direction "Vall d'Hebron" and get off at "**Camp de l'Arpa**" (4 stops). From there you will have to walk 5 minutes to reach the hotel.

If you are staying at any of the <u>three Catalonia hotels</u>, you can go directly from the Airport station to the station called "**Clot**". Catalonia Sagrada Familia, Catalonia Albeniz and Catalonia Atenas hotels are within a short walking distance from the Clot RENFE station.

From Barcelona Sants you take the blue line (L5) with direction Vall d'Hebron and get off at "Sagrada Familia" station (5 stops), if you are staying at the <u>hotel Ayre Rossellón or Happy People Apartments in Calle Sardenya 306</u> and from there it is about 5 minutes walk.

Aerobus Barcelona - Bus service to Barcelona city center from the airport

The Aerobus is a shuttle bus service that links Barcelona airport to the city centre. This service normally runs every 5, 10 or 20 minutes within its fixed hours of operation (see official website below for the exact timetable for the Aerobus). The journey takes about 35 minutes.

You can catch the Aerobus from the airport from both terminals. The Aerobus will then take you to the city centre where you get off at **Plaça de Catalunya**.

From there you take the metro underground.

If you are staying at the <u>Amrey Sant Pau hotel or Htop BCN City</u> you take the green line (L3) with direction "Trinitat Nova" and get off in "**Diagonal**" station. From there you change to the blue line (L5) with direction "Vall d'Hebron" and get off at "**Sant Pau Dos de Maig**" (3 stops). From there you will have to walk 10 minutes to reach the hotel.

If you are staying at the <u>Happy People Apartments Calle Córcega 703</u>, <u>Barcelona</u> you take the green line (L3) with direction "Trinitat Nova" and get off in "**Diagonal**" station. From there you

change to the blue line (L5) with direction "Vall d'Hebron" and get off at "Camp de l'Arpa" (4 stops). From there you will have to walk 10 minutes to reach the hotel.

If you are staying at any of the <u>three Catalonia hotels</u>, from Plaça de Catalunya you can take the metro ounderground, red line (L1) with direction "Fondo" and get off in "Clot" station after 5 stops. Catalonia Sagrada Familia, Catalonia Albeniz and Catalonia Atenas hotels are within a short walking distance from the Clot metro station.

If you are staying at the <u>hotel Ayre Rossellón or Happy People Apartments in Calle Sardenya 306</u>, from Plaça de Catalunya you take the green line (L3) with direction "Trinitat Nova" and get off in "**Diagonal**" station. From there you change to the blue line (L5) with direction "Vall d'Hebron" and get off in "**Sagrada Familia**" (2 stops). Out of the station, it is a 5 minute walk.

Price of a single ticket is 5.90€ for the Aerobus (10.20€ if a return ticket) and then 2.15€ for the Metro ticket (single journey).

Important tip for your return trip: It is important to remember that both Aerobuses for Terminal 1 and for Terminal 2 stop at the same bus stops in the city centre. If you are making your way to Barcelona Airport, make sure that you take the right Aerobus. Both buses look the same, however the bus to T1 is the A1 and the bus to T2 is the A2.

Subway (Metro) - L9 Sud line

Since February 2016, Barcelona city and the airport are linked by a fully automated train service (no human driver).

The Airport Subway ("Metro") line, called **L9 Sud**, runs all the way to Barcelona airport and has stops at both Terminal 1 (inside the building) and Terminal 2 (outside the building). These stops are called **Aeroport T2** and **Aeroport T1**.

The complete journey from the **airport** to the last station lasts about 30 minutes.

On your way to the airport, it is important to consider how long it would take you to reach one of the stations that link to L9 Sud line. The transit time to the L9 Sud is an important time calculation to add to your overall transfer time, as it could take you some time simply to reach the L9 Sud line. This is because the L9 line **does not** directly pass through the major transport hubs such as Plaça Catalunya, Sants estació or Plaça Espanya. You would have to take a connecting metro to reach L9 from these stations. Since these stations all offer direct transport to the Airport it may still be quicker, and more convenient, to use existing transport from one of the principal transport stations.

Depending on where you are starting your journey in the city centre, you would need to work out which is the most convenient route. If you are travelling to or from Plaça Catalunya or Plaça Espanya it may still be more convenient for you to use the Aerobus express bus service because this service runs directly to and from both Catalunya Station and Espanya station without any changes involved. If you are going to or leaving from Sants, or Passeig de Gracia stations and you want to come to or go to Terminal T2 it may be more convenient to use the RENFE airport train as this train runs directly from these stations.

If you are staying at the <u>Amrey Sant Pau hotel or Htop BCN City</u>, you get off at "**Collblanc**" station (12 or 13 stations after T2 and T1) and connect with the metro blue line (L5) with direction "Vall d'Hebron" and get off at "**Sant Pau Dos de Maig**" (9 stops). From there you will have to walk 10 minutes to reach the hotel.

If you are staying at the <u>Happy People Apartments</u>, <u>Calle Córcega 703</u>, <u>Barcelona</u> you get off at "**Collblanc**" station (12 or 13 stations after T2 and T1) and connect with the metro blue line (L5) with direction "Vall d'Hebron" and get off at "**Camp de l'Arpa**" (10 stops). From there you will have to walk 5 minutes to reach the hotel

If you are staying at any of the <u>three Catalonia hotels</u>, you get off at "**Torrassa**" station (11 or 12 stations after T2 and T1) that connects with the metro ounderground, red line (L1) with direction "Fondo" and get off in "**Clot**" station after 5 stops. Catalonia Sagrada Familia, Catalonia Albeniz and Catalonia Atenas hotels are within a short walking distance from the Clot metro station.

If you are staying at the hotel <u>Ayre Rossellón or Happy People Apartments</u>, <u>Calle Sardenya 306</u> you also need to change the metro line at the **Collblanc** station, take the blue line (L5) with direction Vall d'Hebron and get off at "**Sagrada Familia**" station (9 stops) and from there it is about 5 minutes walk to get to the hotel.

Airport Metro Ticket Price

The cost for a single Airport metro ticket is ≤ 4.50 . Note that you cannot use a standard single metro ticket to go to the airport. You **cannot** use the T10 ticket for the subway at Barcelona Airport either.

When you arrive at Barcelona Airport T1 or T2 you will need to validate your ticket in order to exit. If you do not have a valid airport ticket you will need to buy one at the Airport.

Frequency of operation for the Metro to the Airport

The metro to the airport runs every 7 minutes. However if there are heavy demands expected, for example, an exhibition, then the train times may be adjusted to accommodate for the increase in use during these peak hours.

The metro line to the airport operates to the same hours as the normal metro system.

5. Visa to Spain

If you need a visa to enter Spain we kindly ask you to start the process of obtaining a visa as soon as you get the invitation letter for the period of training and stay in Barcelona. An official invitation from the WHO Barcelona Office for Health Systems Strengthening will be sent directly to Embassies available in your countries which issue Schengen visas and copied to you by e-mail.

Extension of the visa during your stay in Spain is impossible. If you plan to visit other countries on your way to or from Spain we recommend you to obtain visa to enter these countries in your national homelands **before departure** to Spain. Otherwise, most of the foreign embassies in Spain will send your visa applications to the consulates located in your countries, which would make it almost impossible to get visas to other countries on time.

Spain is one of the Schengen countries. This means visa obtained for Spain is valid in the following countries: Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Island, Italy, Norway, Luxemburg, Portugal, Greece, Holland, Sweden.

<u>Attention:</u> You will have single entry visa, so you should not leave Schengen area in transit countries (for example, in Great Britain or Switzerland). If it happens, the cost of the visa, airport dues (if these are charged) shall be paid by you or your organization.

6. Weather

October is good time to visit Barcelona if you like the sunshine but want to avoid the intense heat of the preceding months.

By October, although the days are still sunny and warm, the sweltering humidity of August has passed, so once again you are able to enjoy a warm and sunny climate.

The average daytime temperatures are around 21°C whereas the average minimum temperatures drop down to 12°C.

The average amount of sunshine predicted in October is eight hours per day.

Barcelona does have fair chances of rain and cloudy weather in October, though, so it's best to bring a light coat and umbrella just in case. It can rain or drizzle for 10 days throughout the month. The average probability that some form of precipitation will be observed is 34%, with little variation over the month. Throughout October, the most common forms of precipitation are drizzle, light rain, moderate rain and, occasionally, thunderstorms.

7. Time difference

There is Greenwich Mean Time in Spain (GMT+1, in summer - GMT +2).

8. Currency

EURO only is used in the country.

9. Meals

In the period of training the participants will be offered lunches and coffee-breaks. Dinners shall be paid by the participants on their own choice (apart from one course dinner).

Prices may vary from 15 to 50 EURO depending on place. Dinner in a normal café will cost you about 15 EURO. Restaurants are more expensive – 30-50 EURO.

Breakfast is included in most of the rates of the hotels.

10. Mobile communication

Mobile communication of GSM 900 and WCDMA 2100 formats are used in Spain.

11. Safety in Barcelona

Although Barcelona is generally a very safe city, we would like to warn you about pickpockets and advise you to take good care of your belongings in all places and at any time, also in the hotels.
