AGREEMENT

BETWEEN THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR, HEALTH AND SOCIAL AFFAIRS OF GEORGIA

AND

THE MINISTRY OF NATIONAL RESOURCES OF HUNGARY

ON CO-OPERATION IN THE FIELDS OF HEALTH AND MEDICINE

The Ministry of Labour, Health and Social Affairs of Georgia and the Ministry of National Resources of Hungary (hereinafter referred to as "the Contracting Parties") in the spirit of friendship and mutual benefits in the bilateral co-operation, and in the desire to establish co-operation in the fields of health and medicine which is of mutual interest, have agreed as follows:

Article 1

The Contracting Parties shall, on the basis of equality, reciprocity and mutual interest, develop and encourage co-operation in the fields of health and medicine.

Article 2

The Contracting Parties will promote co-operation in the following fields of particular importance:

- 1. Organisation and modernisation of the health sector;
- 2. Health promotion and disease prevention:
- 3. Exchange of experiences on epidemiological surveillance of communicable diseases;
- 4. Pharmaceuticals;
- 5. Medical sciences;
- 6. Exploring possibilities of co-operation in the field of medical education, postgraduate studies and training.

The naming of these fields constitutes a general guideline only and does not exclude the exchange of information and specialists in other field as may be mutually decided.

Article 3

The methods of co-operation of the Contracting Parties are:

- 1. Exchange of information in the field of health;
- 2. Enhancing direct contacts among health institutions;
- 3. Joint development of projects relating to the topics and issues of mutual interest:
- 4. Organisation of joint workshops;
- 5. Exchange of experts and delegations;
- 6. Other agreed forms of co-operation in the fields of health and medical sciences.

Article 4

All exchanges and other forms of co-operation on the basis of this Agreement shall be realised in accordance with the national legislation of the Contracting Parties.

Article 5

If not otherwise agreed, all expenses of visits shall be covered by the sending Party.

Article 6

This Agreement shall enter into force on the date of its signature and shall remain in force, unless denounced by either Party giving at least six (6) months prior written notice to the other Party of its intention to denounce the Agreement.

Signed in Tbilisi on 10th day of May, 2012, in two original copies, in Georgian, Hungarian and English languages. All texts being equally authentic. In case of divergence in interpretation, the English text shall prevail.
