MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR, HEALTH AND SOCIAL AFFAIRS OF GEORGIA

AND

THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR AND SOCIAL ISSUES OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

ON CO-OPERATION

IN THE FIELD OF LABOUR AND SOCIAL ISSUES

The Ministry of Labour, Health and Social Affairs of Georgia and the Ministry of Labour and Social Issues of the Republic of Armenia, hereinafter called the Parties,

Following the successful bilateral cooperation between the Parties in the field of labour and social issues,

Wishing to maintain and extend the existing contacts between the Parties,

Have agreed as follows:

Article 1

The Parties agree to develop co-operation in the field of labour and social issues in accordance with the present Memorandum of Understanding and internal legislation of their states.

Article 2

In the framework of the present Memorandum of Understanding co-operation between the Parties will be implemented in the following directions.

- a) Exchanging experience and information in the field of labour and social issues, provision of mutual consultations;
- b) Extending co-operation between corresponding agencies of the Parties;
- c) Ensuring mutual visits of representatives, specialists and experts from the Parties;
- d) Organization of seminars and conferences on themes of mutual interest with participation of representatives from the Parties.

Article 3

With the purpose of further developing the provisions of the present Memorandum of Understanding, as well as extending frameworks of co-operation in the field of labour and social issues the Parties where necessary will conclude corresponding agreements.

Signed at the city of Yerevan, on 24th of May 2011 in two copies, each in the Georgian, Armenian and English languages, all three texts being equally authentic.
