for Georgia**

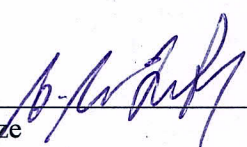
(Determination of Contents of the Study to decide the Components to be procured)

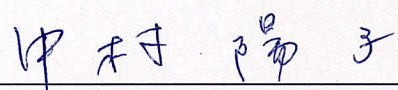
The subject matters in these Minutes of Discussions are confidential between the parties. Any amendment or modification in respect of the Minutes can be made upon mutual written agreement between the parties.

JICS and a specialized consultant will conduct the study with Agent's Fee in order to determine the Components to be procured under the Project. The contents of the study are follows:

1. Objectives of the Study

- (1) To confirm necessity and relevance of the products and the services required by the Recipient.
- (2) To confirm space, capacities and other necessary conditions of the products and the services required by the Recipient.
- (3) To assist the determination of the products and the services to be procured.

2. Products, Services and End-users to be studied

- (1) The candidate products, services, and end-users to be studied are as per Annex-1.
- (2) JICS will gather necessary information according to the priorities of products, services, and end-users described in Annex-1.

3. Recipient's Responsibility for the Study

- (1) The Recipient and/or End-users shall assign persons in charge of the study who coordinate the study closely with JICS.
- (2) The Recipient and/or End-users shall coordinate the study in order that the specialized consultant and JICS may obtain necessary information.
- (3) The Recipient and/or End-users shall submit necessary and/or required document(s) and/or information without delay which are necessary for the study.
- (4) The Recipient and/or End-users shall arrange meetings and/or site visits required by the specialized consultant and JICS.
- (5) The Recipient and/or End-users shall submit the reply to the questionnaire by the date specified by JICS.
