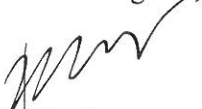
Dear Minister Sergeenko,

I refer to your letter to John Martin dated 4th June 2014. Dr. Martin has passed the note on to me as I am responsible for our worldwide commercial operations and the territory would include Georgia. I apologise for my slow reply.

We thank you for your letter and the progressive position Georgia is taking towards the burden of Hepatitis C in your country. We would like to be part of the solution. To this end we would be happy to meet to discuss your thinking further and to see whether we can come to a mutually acceptable conclusion for the supply of Gilead medicines.

In your letter you suggest a video-call with the Georgian team. John Martin has said that in principle he would be happy to participate in this call.
