As you are aware, Georgia is party to the FCTC 2030 project and receives respective support (funds kindly secured by the UK Government via the FCTC Secretariat). As of May 2018 funding for this project is managed by the WHO Country Office Georgia.

This means that all administrative work is done by our office instead of office of the FCTC Secretariat. We intent to raise an Agreement for Performance of Work in total value that exceeds 25,000 USD.
