

signing annexes to this Agreement. If the mutual agreement cannot be reached, both parties can request immediate termination of the Grant Agreement.

5.3. The Donor is authorized to requests preterm termination of the Grant Agreement, if the Grantee:

- 1) Uses the funds for purposes other than those agreed upon.
- 2) Regularly violates the obligations to the Donor under this Agreement.
- 3) Is no longer able to perform the undertaken obligations as the result of changing its legal status.

5.4. In cases stipulated in the Articles 5.3.1 and 5.3.2 of this Agreement, the Grantee shall return to the Donor the total amount transferred during the project implementation. In case of the Grant Agreement termination stipulated in the Article 5.2, the Grantee shall return to the Donor the unutilised balance from the funds received. If there is any dispute, it will be resolved in accordance with the rules established under the legislation of Georgia.

6. CONCLUDING PROVISION

6.1. The Agreement is made in the Georgian and English languages, in 2-2 (two-two) copies of equal legal force, and is signed by the parties. In case of identifying any discrepancy in the translation, the Georgian text shall prevail.

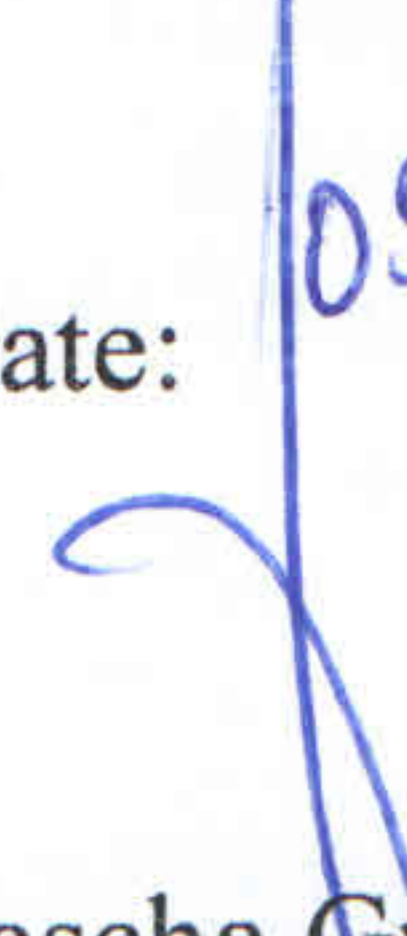
