

GRANT AGREEMENT #2014/006

On one hand, the United Nations Children's Fund UNICEF (hereafter referred to as "Donor"), represented by its Representative Mr. Sascha Graumann, and the National Centre for Disease Control and Public Health of Georgia (hereafter referred to as "Grantee") represented by its General Director, Mr. Amiran Gamkrelidze, make and enter this agreement on the following:

1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 1.1. This agreement is based on the Country Programme Action Plan for 2011-2015 agreed by the Georgian Government and the United Nations Children's Fund, also the Two-Year Rolling Work Plan for 2013-2014 signed by the UNICEF and the Ministry of Labour, Health and Social Affairs of Georgia and is implemented pursuant to the key principles of the UNICEF's Harmonized Approach to Cash Transfers (HACT).

2. SCOPE OF THE AGREEMENT

- 2.1 Within the scope of this agreement, the Donor shall transfer to the Grantee the financial means for implementing the research project **"Effective Vaccine Management (EVM) assessment"** (hereafter referred to as "The Project") which aims to conduct comprehensive assessment of the quality of cold chain and vaccine management at national, subnational and health facility levels. It is based on data collection at the central cold store as well as from a representative sample of districts and health facilities. Its methodology and questionnaires are standardized by WHO and UNICEF at global level. This is a 3-week assessment which requires hiring of two external trained consultants for 3 weeks by Regional Office. The consultants will lead the whole process of assessment, but the assessment itself will be implemented by the National Centre for Disease Control and Public Health of Georgia. The implementing work envisages the following activities:
- Conducting preparatory and operational activities like adaptation and translation of questionnaires.
 - Training of data collectors.
 - Implementation of assessment pre-test.
 - Providing field visits.
 - Providing data entry, processing and analysis.
