- 1. Contracting Activity: The Contracting Activity responsible for this action is the US Army Medical Research Acquisition Activity (USAMRAA), Fort Detrick, MD on behalf the US Army Medical Research Directorate-Georgia (USAMRD-G), Tbilisi, Georgia.
- 2. Description of Action: This approval for a new contract is being request for a Cost-Reimbursement contract with National Center of Disease Control and Public Health (NCDC).
- 3. Description of Supplies/Services: It is the goal of the Government to contract with NCDC for continuous security services for USAMRD-G, Tbilisi, Georgia for adequate mission operation. USAMRD-G is a subunit of Walter Reed Army Institute of Research (WRAIR). USAMRD-G is co-located with NCDC staff at the Richard G. Lugar Center for Public Health Research (referred to as the Lugar Center) located at 16 Kakheti Highway, Alekseevka Settlement #3, 0109, Tbilisi Georgia. This service will provide a daily deterrent against unauthorized, illegal, or potentially life-threatening activities directed toward all employees, visitors, information, programs, property, and the like. NCDC is responsible for payment of the security to the government of Georgia who supplies the services. As occupants of the Lugar Center, USAMRD-G is responsible for 50% of this cost. The estimated cost for these services is \$75,500 USD for the Base Year and \$83,050 USD for Option Year One. Total contract cost is \$158,550 USD.

4. Authority Cited: ...

The statutory authority permitting other than full and open competition is 10 U.S.C. 2304(c)(1). The FAR citation is 6.302-4, services are to be performed in a sovereign territory of another country and the terms of a treaty or agreement specify or limit the sources to be solicited.

5. Reason for Authority Cited: Reference Defense Threat Reduction Agency (DTRA), Memo dated 5 June 2009, Subject: DoD Responsibilities for Establishment and Implementation of the U.S. Georgia Research Center (USGRC) in Tbilisi. This memo establishes that the U.S. Army's presence in the country of Georgia at the Central Reference Laboratory (CRL) in Fiscal Year 2010. The CRL is Richard G. Lugar Center for Public Health Research (referred to as the Lugar Center).
