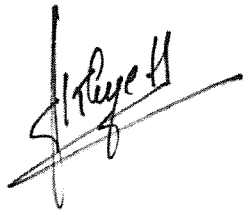

You will receive details of the administrative and practical arrangements for the meeting in due course.

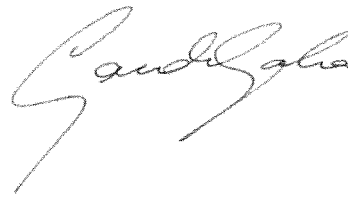
