We hope it will be possible for you to present the ongoing activities in your country/organization on climate change relevant to health.

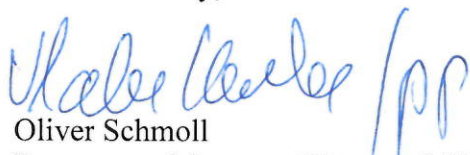
