Fifth Evidence-informed Policy Network (EVIPNet) Europe Multicountry Meeting on Using Research Evidence for Policy-making, Bratislava, Slovakia, 14-16 June 2017

EVIPNet is a WHO initiative that started in 2005 to build capacity of Member States to develop health policies based on the best available research evidence. EVIPNet Europe was launched in October 2012. It supports the implementation of the European Health Information Initiative, the European policy framework Health 2020 and the Action plan to strengthen the use of evidence, information and research for policy-making in the WHO European Region.

The primary objective of the fifth multicountry meeting is to strengthen network-wide organization and coordination, and to support the implementation of evidence-informed policy-making at national level. An outline of the scope and purpose of the meeting is enclosed.
