SUBJECT: Request to the Ministry of Health and Social Affairs of Georgia to provide a list of beneficiaries who will receive wheelchairs provided by US European Command (EUCOM) Humanitarian Assistance project.

1. Purpose. We request a list of beneficiaries who will receive wheelchairs manufactured by the Coalition for Independent Living (CIL) so that CIL can manufacture wheelchairs that are fit individually to each of the beneficiaries.

2. Background. US EUCOM donated \$150,000 to manufacture wheelchairs for the Ministry of Health and Social Affairs of Georgia as a response to the Ministry's letter of April 24, 2015 (#01/28759) to the US Ambassador.

The US Embassy will make a contract with the Coalition for Independent Living (CIL) so that the latter provides sixty one (61) electric and seventy nine (79) manual wheelchairs to the Ministry of Health and Social Affairs of Georgia.

4. Request. To provide a list of beneficiaries to the Coalition for Independent Living (CIL) so that they can manufacture wheelchairs that are designed to fit individually each of the beneficiaries.
