The ISSA European Network (IEN) aims to enhance the opportunities for relevant topical exchanges between member institutions in Europe. Its activities are jointly supported by the IEN Secretariat hosted by a European member institution and the ISSA General Secretariat. A Steering Committee consisting of CEOs from the region provides guidance to the planning and implementation of the IEN activities.

The IEN implements its mandate through the organization of a programme of events responding to the expressed priority topics of European member institutions. This includes a variety of event formats, but generally focusses on small-scale exchange opportunities for senior experts with a preference for interactive and engaging methodologies.

As we approach the end of the current triennium and aim to ensure the continuation as well as the strengthening of the work of the IEN during the coming triennium, we are seeking expressions of interest from CEOs of ISSA member institutions in Europe to serve as a member of the IEN Steering Committee during the next triennium 2020-2022. The principles, tasks and nomination procedures for Steering Committee members are summarized in Annex 1.

Based on the expressions of interest received, the Steering Committee members will be nominated by the ISSA European Bureau members on the occasion of the upcoming World Social Security Forum in Brussels. Each of the five sub-regional groupings in Europe (Annex 2) should be represented by at least one member of the Steering Committee so as to take into account differing sub-regional needs, interests, challenges and priorities.

We very much hope that the ISSA European activities will be able to count on the input of many engaged member institutions in the coming triennium.
