The World Health Organization (WHO) presents its compliments to Member States and Associate Members and has the honour to inform them that WHO is consulting with its Member States to review individual country estimates for healthy ageing indicators (Intrinsic capacity and functional ability) in order to identify and make use of primary data sources that may not have been previously identified.

WHO will release the estimates on healthy ageing on its website and in the global baseline report to support the decade of healthy ageing 2020–2030 in October 2020.

The consultation will be conducted via email with a designated person as focal point. To ensure accurate and timely estimates, Member States who have not yet provided their country estimates are invited to designate a focal point, along with contact details by sending an email to the Department of Maternal, Newborn, Child and Adolescent Health and Ageing (amuthavallithiya@who.int) by 31 July 2020. Further information can also be obtained by sending an email to the same address.

Preliminary estimates and accompanying documentation of methods and data sources will then be emailed to the focal point in the **first week of August 2020**. The country consultation process **will be closed by 5 September 2020**. Any submissions received after this date may not be considered in the final publication of country estimates.

The World Health Organization takes this opportunity to renew to Member States and Associate Members the assurance of its highest consideration.
