- 2. Section A and Section L of the Request for Quotation
- 3. Additional information as required in Section J of the Request for Quotation.

A site visit is scheduled to be conducted on May 29, 2018 at 14:00 at DCMR (54, Sichovykh Striltsiv St., Kyiv, Ukraine).

The registration for the site-visit shall be made not later than May 25, 2018, 15:00. Please provide with your company contact information and name of visitors no later than May 25, 2018, 15:00 to KyivGSO@state.gov.

Participants will be met at the entrance of the DCMR (54, Sichovykh Striltsiv St., Kyiv, Ukraine).

According to U.S. Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR), advance payments are prohibited. Payments may be made upon receipt of goods by the customer. Pursuant to the Prompt Payment Act of the FAR, the U.S. Government must make the payment within 30 calendar days after receipt of the goods and the valid original invoice(s).
